Pharmacy NEWS

In this issue, you'll find the 2008 Preferred Drug List. This list contains most of the medicines covered by First Choice. However, it does not list all covered medicines. New medicines come out all the time, so we change or add to the list regularly. You can also see the list on our website at www.selecthealthofsc.com.

When your doctor gives you a new prescription, ask if the medicine requires prior authorization (approval). If it does, ask if there is another medicine that can be used that does not require approval. Prior authorization means your physician must fill out a form and return it to First Choice. If the request is approved, a notice is sent to your doctor. If the request is not approved, you will get a letter explaining why it is not approved. If you disagree with the reason, you can file an appeal. You may also call the Member Services Department at **888.276.2020** for help filing an appeal. ■



HOW CAN FIRST CHOICE BETTER Serve Your Family?

Each year, a number of First Choice members are randomly chosen to participate in a survey to rate the quality of care and services that they receive from the health plan and their doctor. Survey results will help us to better serve your family's needs and can help you learn more about health plans.

This survey gives you the chance to rate our health plan, your doctors and the healthcare you have received. If you are selected, it is very important that you complete the survey and return it right away!

Our goal is to give you and your family high-quality care and services. We know how important your time and your healthcare are to you and your family. Remember:

- As a First Choice member, you must choose a primary care provider (PCP) from our provider directory to help

your family get needed healthcare.

- Your PCP and First Choice agreed that your waiting time should not exceed 45 minutes for scheduled appointments. This time starts from the time you sign into the office until you are taken to an exam room.
- Keep your appointments and arrive at least 10 minutes early. If you must cancel, give your doctor's office at least 24 hours notice.
- Think about your medical questions before going to the doctor. Write them down and bring them with you.
- Bring a list of your medicines or bring the medicine bottles to the doctor's office.
- While at the doctor's office, listen carefully. If you do not understand what the doctor is telling you, ask questions.
- **You can make a difference!** ■



IMPORTANT TESTS FOR **People with Diabetes**

If you have diabetes, you need to see your doctor regularly and make sure your doctor gives you the following tests:

Hemoglobin A1C. This test is a “snapshot” of your blood sugar for the past three months. It lets the doctor know if your diet or medicine is working. You should have this test two to four times a year.

Lipid Profile. This test shows how much fat is in your blood. If your lipids are high, you could be at risk for a heart attack or stroke. This lets the doctor know if you should take cholesterol medicine. You should have this test every year.

Urine Protein Test. This test makes sure your kidneys are working well and have not been damaged by your diabetes. You should get this test every year.

Foot Exam. The doctor or nurse should check your feet four times a year for circulation problems and sores or red places. You should also check your feet daily.

Dilated Eye Exam. This exam lets the doctor look at the inside of your eyes. Diabetes can make it hard for you to see



clearly. The doctor can check for early problems to help you see better. You should have this test every year. ■

TAKING CARE OF **Yourself and Baby Before Delivery**

One of the best things a pregnant woman can do to have a healthy baby is to have early prenatal care. If you are pregnant or are thinking of becoming pregnant, please follow these important steps:

- Call your OB doctor for an appointment if you think you are pregnant, have missed a period or are planning to become pregnant in the near future.
- It is very important for your health and your baby's health that you get prenatal care in the first trimester or by week 12 of your pregnancy.
- First Choice has a free program for all pregnant women. It is called **Healthy Babies**. If you have special health needs, a **Healthy Babies** Nurse Case Manager will work with you to make sure all of your needs and those of your unborn baby are met. ■

Infants AND Vaccines

Children are immunized in the first few months of life because several diseases, which can be prevented, infect children when they are very young:

- Pertussis (whooping cough) infects about 8,000 children, causing 5 to 10 deaths every year in the United States. Almost all of these children are less than 1 year old.
- Children under 2 years of age are 500 times more likely to catch *Haemophilus influenzae* Type B (Hib) meningitis if someone with an Hib infection is living in the home.
- About 90 percent of newborns whose mothers are infected with hepatitis B will get hepatitis and go on to get chronic liver disease, cirrhosis and sometimes liver cancer.

For these reasons, it is very important for infants to get all their shots against certain diseases by the time they are 6 months old.

Fortunately, young infants are surprisingly good at building protection against viruses and bacteria. About 95 percent of children who get shots for diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTaP), Hib and hepatitis B virus will be fully protected by age 2. ■

Allergy Triggers AND Tips

Spring is a time for allergies.

Allergies can trigger an asthma attack. People can be allergic to lots of things, including pollen from trees and grass, animal dander, dust mites, cockroaches and mold. This is not a complete list of allergens. You need to learn what things cause your asthma symptoms. Here are some tips to control allergens:

- If animal dander is a problem for you, keep your pet out of the house or at least out of your bedroom.
- If pollen is a problem for you, stay indoors with the windows closed and air conditioner on when the pollen count is high.
- To control dust mites, wash your sheets, blankets, pillows and stuffed toys once a week in hot water. Use special dust-proof covers for your mattress and pillows. Remove as much carpeting as possible.
- To avoid cockroaches and other insects in your home, use roach bait or traps or insect spray when no one is at home. Cover up food and clean dishes after eating.
- To control mold, air out damp and humid areas frequently. Clean your bathroom regularly, using products that kill and prevent mold. Use an exhaust fan to vent steam.
- Talk with your family doctor about what triggers your asthma and how you can control it. ■

Vaccines are just for babies and young children.



False. As children get older, the protection provided by some early childhood vaccines can wear off. Children also generally develop risks for more diseases as they become teenagers. For these reasons, older children—including teenagers—need to get their recommended shots. Don't assume that your child received all recommended vaccinations in the past. Talk with your child's doctor about the need for vaccines. ■

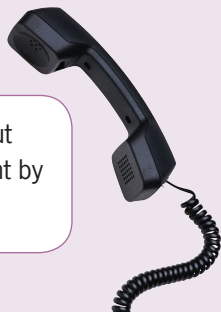
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INTENSIVE Case Management
